

Add Quertle to your Internet Explorer Search function



1. From Internet Explorer, go to :

2. You should see the Create Your Own section of the page that opens.

Create Your Own

Add your own search provider to your copy of Internet Explorer by following these steps:

1. Visit the desired search engine in another window or tab
2. Use the search engine to search for TEST (all capital letters)
3. Paste the URL of the Search results page URL:

4. In the box after step 4, enter "Quertle" as the name.

Create Your Own

Add your own search provider to your copy of Internet Explorer by following these steps:

1. Visit the desired search engine in another window or tab
2. Use the search engine to search for TEST (all capital letters)

http://www.quertle.info/search?s=r&query=TEST&so_a=&so_j=

4. Specify a name for the search provider Name:

Quertle

If your search provider doesn't install correctly, [click here](#) to select another character encoding.

5. Click **Install**. Then click **Add** in the **Do you want to add this search provider** alert box. That's it. Now, whenever you want to search Quertle, you can simply enter your query terms directly in Internet Explorer's search tool, then click on the drop arrow and choose Quertle.

6. If you would like to make Quertle your default search, choose **Manage Search Providers** from the search drop-down list, select **Quertle**, then click the **Set as Default** button.
